TASTER WORKSHOP CONTENT & TOPICS

You will be asked to do a simple 1 minute introduction of yourself to the camera. This should be a; who, what, why and where type of piece about yourself. For example, who are you (name, where you are from), what you do normally in the day, why you have come on the workshop. You can finish the piece off by describing something that you are interested in, this can be an unusual hobby or pastime.

We will record, play back and critique your piece, in studio, with lights, green screen and audio with the trainer and peer group to help improve your on-camera communication.

Before the workshop, have a think about what you would like to say, we will chat about it at the workshop. You do not have to write a long script, this is a short introduction and should not last over 1 minute.
