CONTENT & TOPICS

You will be asked to do a simple 1 minute introduction of yourself to the camera. This should be a; who, what, why and where type of piece about yourself. For example, who are you (name, where you are from), what you do normally in the day, why you have come on the workshop. You can finish the piece off by describing something that you are interested in, this can be an unusual hobby or pastime.

You will record an autocue piece, and do a co-presenting piece with a member of the class. We will record, play back and critique your excersises to camera, in studio, with lights, green screen and audio with the trainer and peer group to help improve your on-camera communication.

Prior to the day, have a think about what you will talk about in your first piece to camera, and we'll work on your script with you at the workshop.
